STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in aid of navigation on Rangeley Lake, Mooselucmeguntic Lake and Cupsuptic Lake.

Resolved, That the sum of four hundred dollars is hereby
2 appropriated for removing obstructions and for the placing
3 of buoys in Rangeley Lake, Mooselucmeguntic Lake and
4 Cupsuptic Lake and for the erection of lights in Rangeley
5 Lake, Mooselucmeguntic Lake and Cupsuptic Lake and the
6 maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred and
7 nine, and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and ten.
8 Said buoys and lights shall be placed at such points in said
9 lakes as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon. All
10 said moneys shall be expended under the direction of State
11 steamboat inspectors. Any part of the money hereby ap-
12 propriated for removing obstructions, for the placing of

13 buoys and lights and maintenance of lights which shall be
14 unexpended at the end of the year nineteen hundred and ten
15 shall revert to the State.
