IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 79 of the private and special laws of 1905, relating to fishing in Great Brook and tributaries in Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of chapter 79 of the private and special laws of 1905 as prohibits fishing in Great brook, so-called, in Stoneham, in Oxford county, above the falls on said brook near the Hilton-McAllister place, so-called, and in the tributaries to said Great brook, including Beaver brook, so-called, Willard brook, so-called, Shirley brook, so-called, and Red Rock brook, so-called, in accordance with the general law of the State, is hereby repealed.
