AN ACT to make valid the organization of the Rice Public
Library of Kittery, Maine, organized under Chapter 57 of
the Revised Statutes in the year 1903.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The organization of the Rice Public Library in
2 Kittery, Maine, under Chapter 57 of the Revised Statutes,
3 in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three,
4 is hereby made valid and all its past acts are hereby made
5 valid and legal.
