STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Mousam Long Pond, so called,
in the towns of Shapleigh and Acton, York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time on or through the ice in
3 Mousam Long pond, so called, in the towns of Shapleigh
4 and Acton, in York county, under the same penalty as is
5 provided in the general law of the State for the illegal fish-
6 ing for and catching trout and landlocked salmon.

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
2 police courts and trial justices within their respective coun-
3 ties shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent

4 jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and superior courts,
5 and all fines, forfeitures and penalties received for any
6 violation of this act shall be paid forthwith by the person
7 receiving the same to the State Treasurer, and credited to
8 fines and license fees for the protection of birds and game.
