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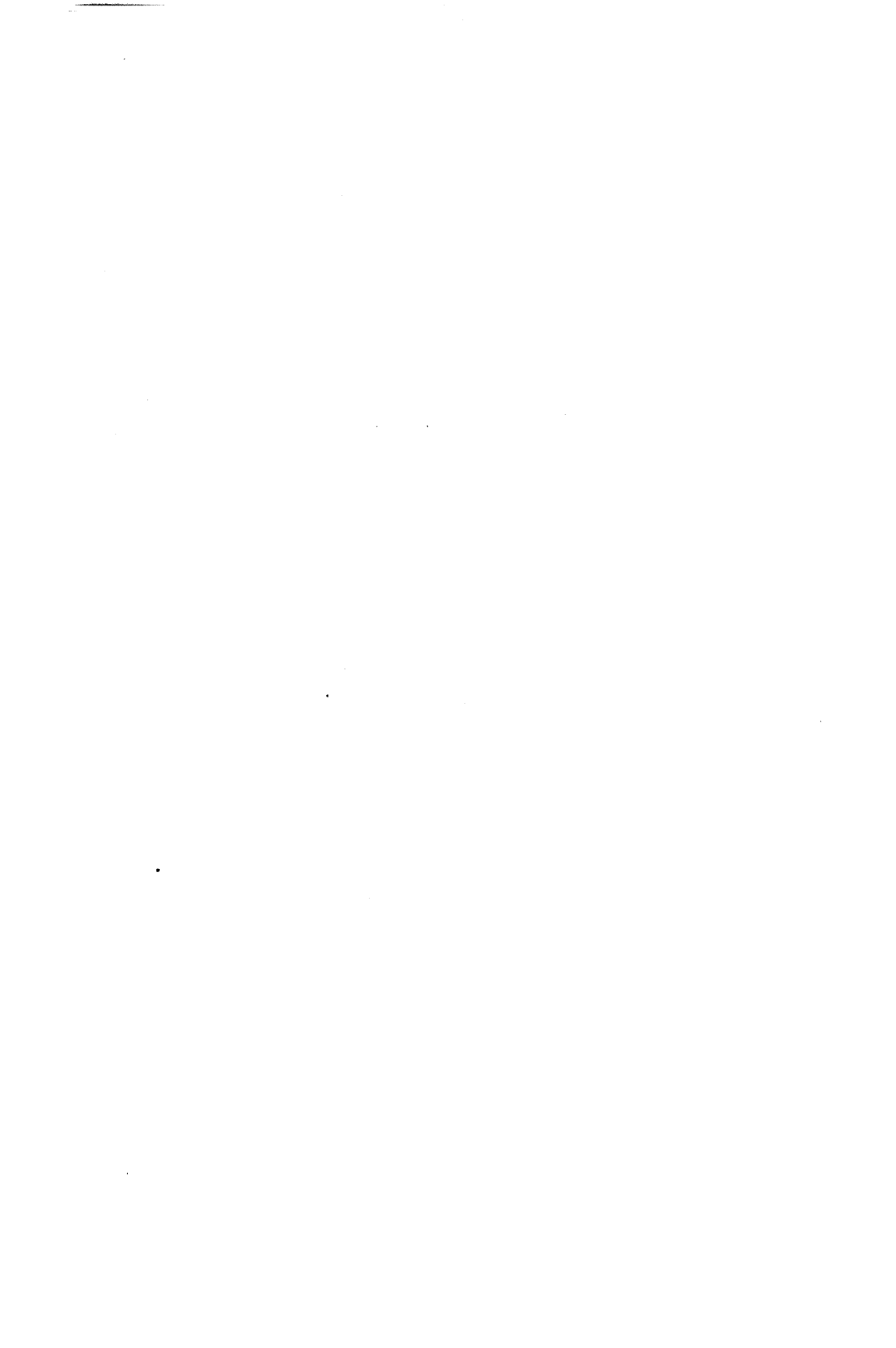
## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of the town of Eddington.

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*Resolved,* That there be paid to the town of Eddington  
2 the sum of sixty-six dollars, this sum being the amount due  
3 that town for maintenance of a free high school during the  
4 school year ending July 1, 1905.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Eddington maintained a free high school during the school year ending July 1, 1905. The sum of \$132.00 was paid, during this period, for the board and wages of teachers, but the school authorities of the town failed to make a return to the State Superintendent of Public Schools as provided in section sixty-five of chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes. Under the provisions of section fifty-five of the same chapter the town is entitled to one-half of the above amount or \$66.00.
