
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT relating to portable or movable saw mills in cities
or incorporated towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall operate a portable or movable
2 saw mill in any city or incorporated town in this State with-
3 out first having procured a license therefor from the muni-
4 cipal officers of the city or town in which said mill is pro-
5 posed to be operated, and the municipal officers may require
6 a reasonable bond with sureties in such sum as they may
7 determine, to reimburse any person or persons for any dam-
8 age sustained by fire in consequence of the operation of such
9 mill.

Sect. 2. The Forest Commissioner shall furnish, free of
2 charge, proper printed forms, upon which said mill opera-
3 tors shall report date of erecting mill and location of same;
4 all fires and cause, if known, in the vicinity of said mill; and
5 all damage to property not owned by them, and return to
6 said Forest Commissioner.
