AN ACT to regulate the taking of eels in Taunton Bay, town of  
Franklin.

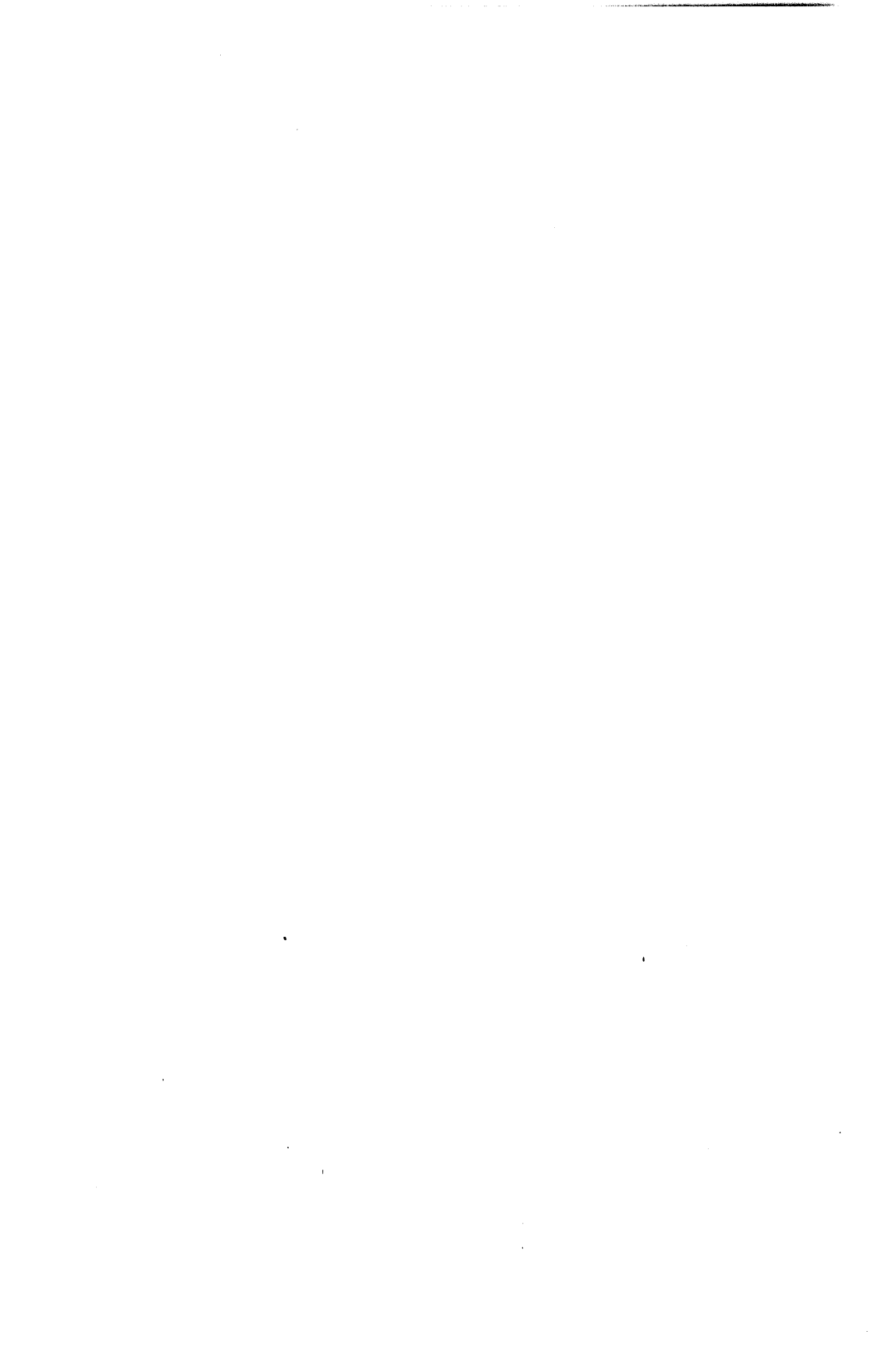

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. No person shall be allowed during the months  
2 of December, January, February and March of each year,  
3 to take eels by the use of nets, spears, or by any means what-  
4 ever from Taunton Bay in the town of Franklin, so far up  
5 said bay as the tide waters extend.

Sect. 2. If any person shall take eels from said bay in  
2 violation of the provisions of this act, he shall be punished by  
3 a fine not exceeding \$5 for each offense; one half to the use  
4 of the complainant and the other half to the use of the town  
5 in which such complaint shall be made.
