IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Paragraph V, of Section Thirty, of Chapter Eighteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to by-laws of local boards of health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph V, of section thirty, of chapter eighteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting
2 after the word "county" in the seventh line thereof the words
3 'or by posting copies of said by-laws in six conspicuous and
4 public places within the town;' also by inserting after the
5 word "publication" in the eighth line thereof the words
6 'or posting,' so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read
7 as follows:
8

'V. Make, alter and amend such orders and by-laws as

10 they shall think necessary and proper for the preservation of
11 life and health and the successful operation of the health
12 laws of the State, subject to the approval of any justice of the
13 supreme judicial court. Notice shall be given by the board
14 of health, of all by-laws made or amended by them, by pub-
15 lishing the same in some newspaper, if there is one published
16 in such town; if there is none, then in the nearest newspaper
17 published in the county; or by posting copies of said by-laws
18 in six conspicuous and public places within the town; and a
19 record of such publication, or posting, of said orders and by-
20 laws in the office of the town clerk, shall be deemed a legal
21 notice to all persons.'
