RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Nobleboro.

Resolved: That there be paid to the town of Nobleboro
2 the sum of two hundred and three dollars and fifty cents, this
3 sum being the amount due that town on account of tuition
4 of pupils in secondary schools for the year ending July 1,
5 1907.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Under the provisions of Sections 63 and 64 of Chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes the sum of two hundred and three dollars and fifty cents is due the town of Nobleboro. This town expended during the year ending July 1, 1907, the sum of four hundred and seven dollars for tuition of pupils in secondary schools. The failure of the superintending school committee to forward a claim for this amount until after the appropriation covering this school year was closed has made it necessary to resort to this method of securing a payment.
