RESOLVE, in favor of the County Commissioners of Franklin County for the repair and permanent improvement of the road from Madrid line through letter E. Plantation and Sandy River Plantation.

*Resolved,* That the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars 2 be and is hereby appropriated for the repair and permanent 3 improvement of the road leading from Madrid line through 4 letter E. Plantation and Sandy River Plantation, to the old 5 original highway from Phillips to Rangeley in Franklin 6 County; the same to be drawn by and expended under the 7 direction of the County Commissioners of Franklin County.
