## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of screening Taylor lake, in Androscoggin County.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be and 2 is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and 3 ten, to be paid out of the general appropriation for the 4 operation of the fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish 5 and for the protection of fish, for the purpose of screening 6 Taylor lake, so-called, in the city of Auburn, in Androscog-7 gin county, to be expended under the direction of the Com-8 missioners of Inland Fisheries and Game, when the bal-9 ance necessary to erect said screen, as found by the com-10 missioners, shall have been raised by the citizens of Andros-11 coggin county, and paid into the treasurer of State for this 12 purpose.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be 14 available until the city government of said city of Auburn 15 shall have, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability 16 for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, 17 leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clog-18 ged and prevent the free running of the water through the 19 same.

Provided, further, that in this and all other resolves appropriating money for the screening of any lake or pond, if the town or city therein named does not comply with the provisions of the resolve, the money appropriated therein shall not lapse and be turned into the State treasurer, but shall be expended by the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game for the operation of the fish hatcheries and the protection of fish.
