STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of screening Estes lake, so-called, situated partly in the town of Sanford and partly in the town of Alfred, in York County.

Resolved, That the sum of nine hundred and seventy-five
2 dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen
3 hundred and ten, to be paid out of the general appropria-
4 tion for the operation of the fish hatcheries and feeding sta-
5 tions for fish and for the protection of fish, for the purpose
6 of screening Estes lake, so-called, situated partly in the
7 town of Sanford and partly in the town of Alfred, in York
8 County, to be expended under the direction of the Commis-
9 sioners of Inland Fisheries and Game, when the balance
10 necessary to erect said screen, as found by the commis-
11 sioners, shall have been raised by the citizens of York coun-

12 ty, and paid into the treasurer of State for this purpose.
13 Provided, further, that should this appropriation be found
14 to be inadequate and the citizens of York county fail to
15 raise the balance necessary to erect said screen, as above
16 provided, the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game
17 are hereby authorized to use this sum for screening such
18 other lake or lakes in the State as in their judgment they
19 may deem for the best interests of the State.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be
21 available for the purpose of screening said Estes lake until
22 the town of Sanford shall have, in legal town meeting, and
23 having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for
24 that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability
25 for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks,
26 leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clog-
27 ged and prevent the free running of the water through the
28 same.
