STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of screening Toddy pond, in the town of
Orland, in Hancock county.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be and
2 is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and
3 ten, to be paid out of the general appropriation for the
4 operation of the fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish
5 and for the protection of fish, for the purpose of screening
6 Toddy pond, so-called, in the town of Orland, in Hancock
7 county, to be expended under the direction of the Commis-
8 sioners of Inland Fisheries and Game, when the balance
9 necessary to erect said screen, as found by the commis-
10 sioners, shall have been raised by the citizens of Hancock

11 county, and paid into the treasurer of State for this pur-
12 pose.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be avail-
14 able until the town of Orland shall have, in legal town
15 meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town
16 meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted to as-
17 sume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times
18 free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will
19 not become clogged and prevent the free running of the
20 water through the same.
