### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of screening Spring River lake, situated partly in Washington county, and partly in Hancock county.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be and is 2 hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and ten, 3 to be paid out of the general appropriation for the operation 4 of the fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish and for 5 the protection of fish, for the purpose of screening Spring 6 River lake, so-called, situated partly in Washington county 7 and partly in Hancock county, to be expended under the 8 direction of the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and 9 Game, when the balance necessary to erect said screen, as 10 found by the commissioners, shall have been raised by the 11 inhabitants of the County of Washington, and paid into the 12 treasurer of State for this purpose.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be available until the town of Cherryfield shall have, in legal town meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of the water through the same.
