STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-three of the Public Laws of
nineteen hundred five, relating to Contagious Diseases among
Cattle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter eighty-three of the Public
Laws of nineteen hundred five is amended by adding as
the last clause thereof the following:

“Except in cases of cattle that have been so tested and
certified within twelve months previous to such sale, or
calves under four months old.”

Sect. 2. Section four of said act is hereby repealed and
the following section enacted as section four:

'Section 4. Whoever violates any provision of the three
4 preceeding sections shall be punished by a fine of not less
5 than twenty-five dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each
6 offense.'
