STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Webb's river and tributaries in Franklin county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or 2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Webb's river, in the 3 county of Franklin, from Goodwin Brothers' mill dam, in 4 Carthage, to the town line between the town of Carthage 5 and the town of Dixfield, or in any of the tributaries to said 6 Webb's river in said town of Carthage, except on Tuesday 7 and Friday of each week from the time the ice goes out of 8 the waters fished in in the spring of each year until October 9 first following, and during open season on the above named

10 waters no person shall take, catch or kill more than 25 fish 11 in all in any one day in any of said waters.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in 3 the general law of the State for the illegal fishing for and 4 catching of trout and land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and 2 police courts and trial justices, within their respective coun-3 ties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent 4 jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and superior courts, 5 and all fines, penalties and forfeitures recovered by any 6 person for any violation of this act shall be paid forthwith 7 by the person receiving the same to the State treasurer, to 8 be credited to fines and license fees for the protection of 9 birds and game.
