House Amendment B to House Document 530.

Amend House Document 530 entitled "An Act to regulate use of joint poles in the public streets by electrical companies" by adding the following:

Whenever against the objection of said persons, firms, or corporations on the ground of danger to the persons or property of third persons a change of the location of its poles and wires is made by order of the municipal officers of any town or city, such town or city shall be liable to any person suffering loss, cost or damage arising or in any way coming from such change, and said persons, firms or corporations shall be released from all liability for such loss, cost or damage.
