STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Bingham.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred eighty-one dollars 2 and twenty-five cents, the unexpended balance of an appro-3 priation in aid of the town of Bingham, voted by the sev-4 enty-third legislature, be and is hereby appropriated to aid 5 the town of Bingham in building and repairing the highway 6 landing to the Bingham and Concord bridge, to be expended 7 under the direction of the county commissioners of Somer-8 set county.

But the appropriation shall not deprive the town of Bing-10 ham of the right to draw from the State the full amount 11 of money in aid of her highways to which said town would 12 be entitled under the laws of the State to aid towns in the 13 construction or maintenance of State highways.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The seventy-third Legislature appropriated a sum of \$564.03 to the town of Bingham for building and repairing the approach to the Bingham and Concord bridge, and there is an unexpended balance of \$181.25, which, by virtue of the act relating to the State Auditor, reverts back to the State. On account of the Road Commissioner of Bingham not understanding the law, the total amount was not expended during the past two years. The matter was not understood until Bingham had her annual meeting March 1st.

This resolve simply calls for the unexpended balance.
