STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate the hunting of deer in the towns of Camden, Rockport and Hope, in Knox county, and in the towns of Lincolnville and Searsmont, in Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. For a period of three years from the time this
2 act takes effect it shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch,
3 kill or destroy any deer at any time in the towns of Cam-
4 den, Rockport and Hope, in Knox County, or in the towns
5 of Lincolnville and Searsmont, in Waldo County.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-
7 sion at any time any deer taken in either of the above named
8 towns.

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act shall be
10 subject to the same penalty as is provided in the general
11 law of the State for the illegal hunting, chasing, catching
12 and killing of deer.

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions arising under this act, municipi-
2 pal and police courts and trial justices within their respec-
3 tive counties shall have, upon complaint, original and con-
4 current jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and superior
5 courts, and all fines, penalties and forfeitures recovered by
6 any person for any violation of this act shall be paid forth-
7 with by the person receiving the same to the State treasurer
8 and credited to license fees and fines for the protection of
9 birds and game.
