IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit certain persons from advertising as State
Detectives.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person licensed
2 as a private detective, under chapter thirty-one of the
3 Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter nine of the Pub-
4 lic Laws of 1907, to advertise or represent himself as a
5 State detective, under penalty of the forfeiture of his license
6 and a fine not to exceed twenty dollars, to be recovered
7 upon complaint.
