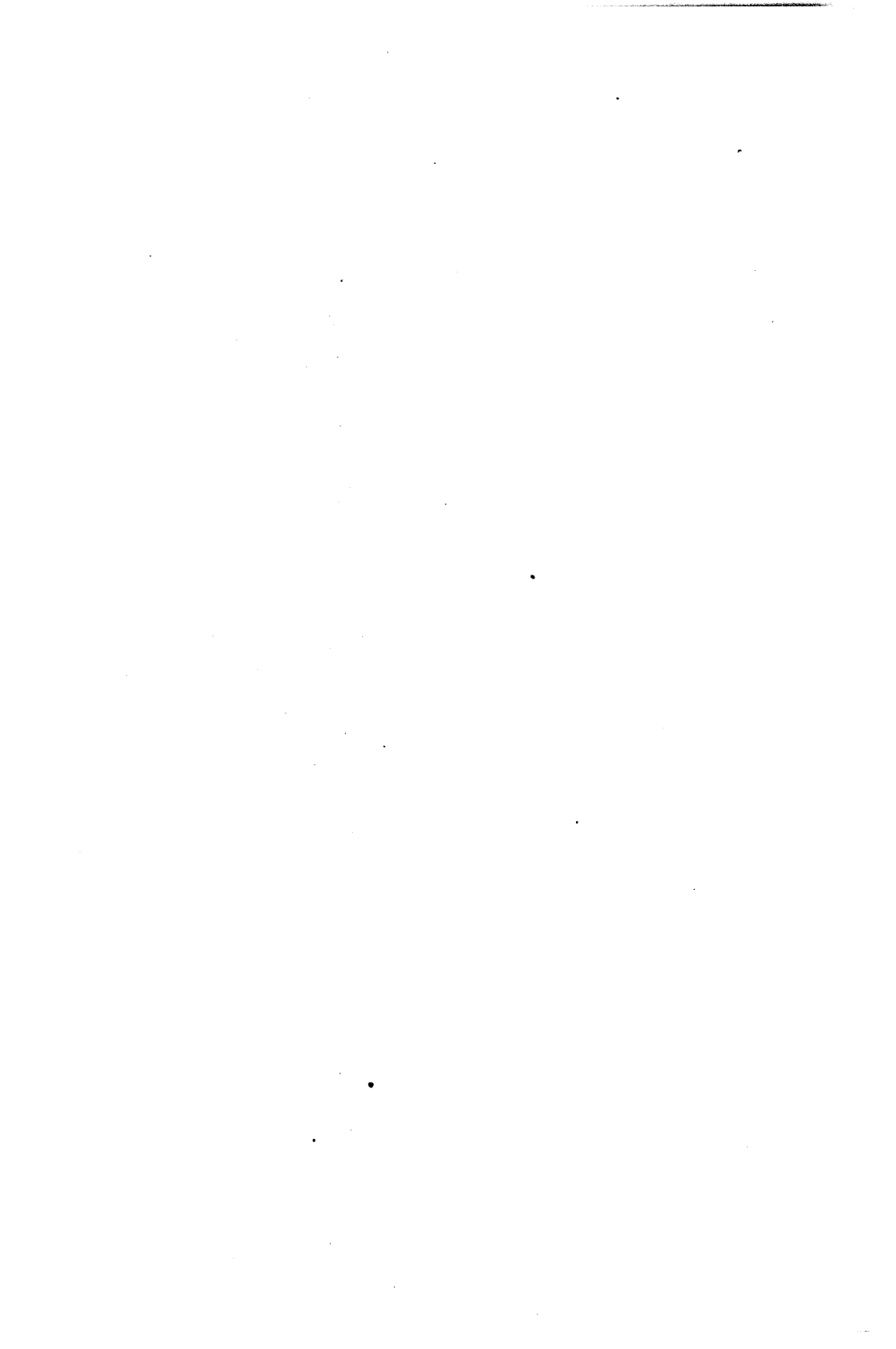

AN ACT to authorize the appointment of deputy sealers of
weights and measures.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The municipal officers of cities and towns
2 may appoint a deputy sealer of weights and measures, to
3 hold office during their pleasure, and fix his compensation.
4 Such deputy shall act under the direction of the sealer of
5 weights and measures in the municipality, and shall have
6 the same authority as the sealer in the performance of his
7 duties.
