IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section seventy-two of chapter four of the
Revised Statutes relating to Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section seventy-two of chapter four of the Re-
vised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the
words: 'and a reasonable sum to secure, grade and care for
a lot appropriate for such a monument,' so that said section,
as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 72. Cities and towns may raise money to procure
the writing and publication of their histories, to celebrate
any centennial or other anniversary of the settlement or in-
corporation of such city or town, and to publish the pro-
ceedings of any such celebration, to defray the expenses of

11 the observance of memorial day and of old home week, and
12 a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars in any one town for
13 erecting a suitable monument in memory of the soldiers who
14 sacrificed their lives in defense of their country in the war
15 of eighteen hundred and sixty-one, and a reasonable sum to
16 secure, grade and care for a lot appropriate for such a monu-
17 ment.'
