STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section ten of chapter two hundred fortynine of the Private and Special Laws of 1905, entitled "An Act to authorize the Maine and New Brunswick Electrical Power Company, Limited, of New Brunswick, to exercise certain powers in this State."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section ten of said chapter is hereby amended 2 by inserting after the word "Houlton" in the seventy-3 seventh line thereof the following, 'and the towns and vil-4 lages of Linneus, Hodgdon, Ludlow, New Limerick and 5 Hammond Plantation,' and by striking out in the last line 6 of said section the word "town" and inserting the follow-

7 ing, 'towns and said plantation.' So that the last para-8 graph of said section as amended shall read as follows:

'The Houlton Water Company is hereby specially author-10 ized and empowered to contract for, buy, make, generate 11 and use electricity upon its property in the town of Houl-12 ton, in the county of Aroostook, or other property here-13 after acquired by said Houlton Water Company for the 14 purpose, and to transmit, conduct and distribute such elec-15 tricity to, into and throughout the town and village of said 16 Houlton and the towns and villages of Linneus, Hodgdon, 17 Ludlow, New Limerick and Hammond Plantation, and sell 18 and supply the same for lighting such public streets and 19 such buildings and places therein, public and private, as 2C may be agreed upon by said company and the owners or 21 those having control of such streets and places to be lighted, 22 and may transmit, sell and supply the same for heating, 23 motive power, manufacturing or mechanical purposes in 24 said towns and said plantation.'
