IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and ninety-eight of
the Private and Special Laws of 1907 relating to records of
real estate in the County of Waldo.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter one hundred and nine-
2 ty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of 1907 is hereby
3 amended by striking out all after the word "index" in the
4 sixth line thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the follow-
5 ing: 'which shall show in addition to the names of the par-
6 ties and the nature of the instrument, the year of the instru-
7 ment and the year of its record and the name of the town,
8 city or unincorporated place where the land conveyed is

9 situated,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as
10 follows:

'Sect. 2. The copies shall be made on paper of the kind
12 and quality used for recording deeds in the registry of
13 deeds for said county of Waldo and shall be bound into
14 books corresponding in size and quality now in use in said
15 office, and shall be indexed in the form known as ledger
16 index, which shall show in addition to the names of the
17 parties and the nature of the instrument, the year of the
18 instrument and the year of its record and the name of the
19 town, city or unincorporated place where the land is sit-
20 uated.'
