AN ACT to incorporate the Gregory Sanatorium.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows;

Section 1. Dr. George A. Gregory, Dr. E. A. Sprague and

- 2 Emma B. Day, their associates and successors, are hereby
- 3 incorporated and made a body politic by the name of Gregory
- 4 Sanitorium and by that name may sue and be sued and may
- 5 have a common seal and shall have all the immunities and
- 6 privileges and be subject to all the liabilities of like cor-7 porations.
- Sect. 2. Said corporation may take, receive, purchase, hold
- 2 and possess land and tenements in fee simple or otherwise
- 3 and dispose of and sell the same and may erect, sup-

7 bay Harbor.

- 4 port and maintain a hospital for the treatment of the sick, 5 for the training of nurses and for the advancement of the 6 science of medicine, to be located within the town of Booth-
- Sect. 3. The said hospital shall be under the direction and 2 management of three trustees who shall be chosen at the 3 first meeting, one for the term of one year, one for the term 4 of two years and one for the term of three years; and at 5 each subsequent annual meeting one trustee shall be chosen 6 for a term of three years. Any vacancies in the board oc-7 curring between such annual meetings shall be filled by the 8 board and the trustees so chosen shall hold office until the
- Sect. 4. A majority of the trustees shall constitute a 2 quorum for the transaction of business. Said corporation 3 shall have the power to make such by-laws as may be neces-4 sary to provide for the government of the hospital, not re-5 pugnant to the laws of the State.

o next annual meeting or until others are chosen in their stead.

Sect. 5. Any one of the corporators named in this act 2 may call the first meeting of the corporators by mailing a 3 written notice, to each of the other corporators seven days 4 at least before the day of meeting, naming the time, place 5 and purpose of such meeting.
