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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to create a board of trustees for the Sullivan-  
Franklin Bridge.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The citizens of the towns of Sullivan and  
2 Franklin shall constitute a body politic and corporate under  
3 the name of the Trustees of Sullivan-Franklin Bridge, for  
4 the purpose of building and maintaining a bridge between  
5 said towns.

Sect. 2. Said trustees are hereby authorized and empow-  
2 ered to erect and maintain a bridge over the Narrows of  
3 Taunton River; said bridge shall be built of suitable ma-

4 terials, shall not be less than eighteen feet in width, and  
5 shall in all respects be made safe for the passage of travelers.

Sect. 3. The inhabitants of the town of Sullivan and the  
2 inhabitants of the town of Franklin may raise and appro-  
3 priate money each year, and expend the same under the  
4 direction of said trustees, in building, constructing and  
5 maintaining said bridge.

Sect. 4. The affairs of said trustees shall be managed by  
2 a board of fourteen members, seven of whom shall be se-  
3 lected by the inhabitants of each of said towns, and they  
4 shall hold office for one year.

Sect. 5. Said board of trustees may make and adopt from  
2 time to time, such rules, by-laws and regulations for the  
3 management of the affairs of the trustees, as they deem  
4 necessary and proper.

Sect. 6. The following named citizens of Sullivan: C.  
2 H. Abbott, Will R. Havey, H. H. Havey, W. B. Blaisdell,  
3 Bradbury Smith, R. H. Springer, H. W. Dunbar, and the  
4 following named citizens of Franklin: Lincoln Bragdon,  
5 Frank E. Blaisdell, Sherman S. Scammons, Frank Bradbury,  
6 Willie Bragdon, W. A. Havey and John Fickett, shall be  
7 and are hereby constituted the first board of trustees au-  
8 thorized by this act, and shall hold office until the last day  
9 of March, nineteen hundred and ten, after such bridge  
10 shall be completed and opened to the public.

Sect. 7. Said trustees shall render their services without  
2 compensation.

Sect. 8. The first meeting of the board of trustees named  
2 in this act may be called at the request of any one of said  
3 board, by giving each member personal notice of the time,  
4 place and purpose of said meeting.
