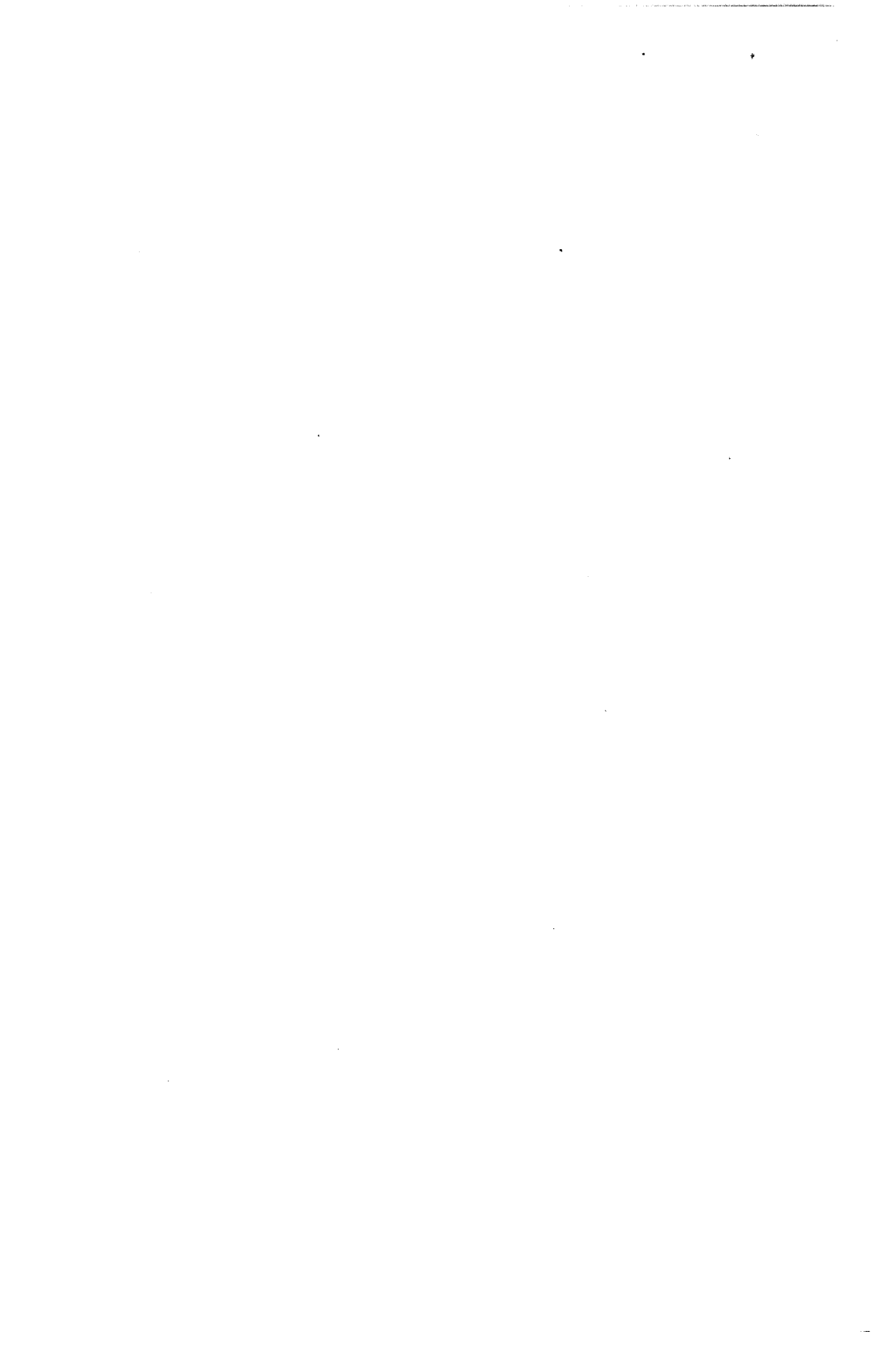
AN ACT to amend section two of chapter twenty-two of the Revised Statutes of the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three, relating to jail sentence for maintaining a liquor nuisance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1.. Section two of chapter twenty-two of the
2 Revised Statutes of the year of our Lord one thousand nine
3 hundred and three is hereby amended by inserting after
4 "not" in the first line the words 'less than one hundred dol-
5 lars and.' Said section is further amended by striking out
6 the word "or" in the second line and inserting in its place
7 the word 'and.' Said section is further amended by in-

8 setting after the word “not” in the second line the words
9 ‘less than thirty days and not.’ Said section is further
10 amended by adding after the word “year” the words, ‘and
11 in default of payment of said fine an additional imprison-
12 ment of thirty days in jail,’ so that said section as amended
13 shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 2. Whoever keeps or maintains such nuisance, shall
15 be fined not less than one hundred dollars and not exceed-
16 ing one thousand dollars, and imprisoned in jail not less
17 than thirty days and not more than one year, and in de-
18 fault of payment of said fine an additional imprisonment
19 of thirty days in jail.’
