STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit the throwing of sawdust and other mill waste into Ferguson Stream in the town of Wellington in the County of Piscataquis and the town of Cambridge in the County of Somerset.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall put, or allow the same to be
2 done by any person within his employ, into Ferguson Stream
3 in the town of Wellington in the County of Piscataquis and
4 in the town of Cambridge in the County of Somerset, any
5 mill waste, slabs, edgings, sawdust, or any other mill waste
6 of a fibrous nature created in the manufacture of any sawed
7 or planed lumber, or to place or deposit the same on the bank

8 of said Ferguson Stream in such negligent or careless man-
9 ner that the same shall fall or be washed into said Fergu-
10 son Stream, or with the intent that the same shall fall or be
11 washed into said Ferguson Stream.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of
2 this act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than fifty
3 dollars nor more than one hundred dollars and costs of pros-
4 ecution for each offense.
