STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of navigation on Levy, Long and Big
Lakes.

Resolved, There be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of one hundred and fifty dollars for buoys and replacing
3 buoys to be laid out under the steamboat inspectors direction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

These lakes are full of shoals and are connected by narrows making it difficult to navigate without buoying the channels.
