IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the time within which the Madison Municipal Court may be organized.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. The time in which the Madison Municipal
2 Court, authorized by chapter four hundred and thirty-seven
3 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and
4 seven, may be organized is hereby extended for the term of
5 two years from the time when this act shall take effect.
