## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of State House Employees.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of twenty-five dollars be paid to  
2 each of the regular State House employees who have served  
3 under the superintendent of public buildings more than  
4 one year, for extra services rendered during the session of  
5 the legislature, thirteen in number, amounting to three  
6 hundred and twenty-five dollars.



## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It has been customary for a number of years to give the employees of the Department of Superintendent of Public Buildings the amount mentioned in the resolve. For about two months before the session, there is a large amount of extra work to do, such as taking up, cleaning and putting down carpets and rugs, painting, repairing, and cleaning the rooms, moving the departments that have to be moved, putting in extra tables, desks and furniture of different kinds. After the close of the session, the whole State House is cleaned, the departments that were moved before the session, moved back to their regular rooms, the furniture placed back in the store room. During the session, the regular mail carrier carries a large amount of mail belonging to the Legislature. All this extra work is done by the regular employees, before the extra help come on and after they leave.
