IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. No motor vehicle shall be operated upon any  
2 highway or street in the State of Maine during the period  
3 when said vehicle is required to display lights, unless the  
4 rear register number of said vehicle is illuminated so that  
5 the register numbers shall be plainly visible at a distance  
6 of sixty feet, and unless the two front lights have upon  
7 each of them the registered number of said motor vehicle,  
8 so that the said numbers shall be plainly visible at a dis-  
9 tance of sixty feet.

Sect. 2. Any person operating a motor vehicle in viola-  
2 tion of this act shall be fined a sum not less than ten dollars.
