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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend section fifteen of chapter fifty-four of the Revised Statutes, relating to expenses of the inspector of boilers, engines, etc., of steamboats upon inland waters.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section fifteen of chapter fifty-four of the  
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding, after the  
3 word "chapter," in line four of said section, the following  
4 words: 'and the inspector of boilers, engines and their ap-  
5 purtenances shall receive annually, in equal quarterly pay-  
6 ments upon the first days of January, April, July and Octo-  
7 ber, in addition to the salary and expenses now allowed by .

8 law, and in lieu of allowance for office-rent and clerk-hire,  
9 the sum of two hundred dollars.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of July,  
2 one thousand nine hundred nine.
