STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to amend chapter one hundred and twenty-six of the Resolves of nineteen hundred and five, as amended by chapter seventy-nine of the Resolves of nineteen hundred and seven, relating to the Central Maine Fair Association.

Resolved, That chapter one hundred and twenty-six of the 2 Resolves of nineteen hundred and five, as amended by 3 chapter seventy-nine of the Resolves of nineteen hundred 4 and seven, be and is hereby amended by striking out the 5 words "five hundred" in the first line of said chapter, and 6 by striking out all after the word "amount" in the fourth 7 line, and substituting in place thereof the following, 'Said 8 society may draw said appropriation upon its voucher that 9 such amount has been paid out for strictly agricultural and

Io dairy purposes;' so that said chapter as amended shall read II as follows:

'Resolved, That the sum of two thousand dollars be and 13 is hereby appropriated annually for the Central Maine Fair 14 Association, provided that the above named society shall 15 annually appropriate an equal amount to be paid in pre-16 miums for stock, dairy and agricultural products. Said 17 society may draw said appropriation upon its voucher that 18 such amount has been paid out for strictly agricultural and 19 dairy purposes.'
