STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Chase Brook and tributaries and
in a portion of Fish river, in the county of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Chase brook, so-called, or
3 in any of its tributaries, or in Fish river, so-called, from the
4 falls on said river near Big Fish lake, so-called, to the mouth
5 of said Chase brook, all in the county of Aroostook. Who-
6 ever violates any of the provisions of this section shall be
7 subject to the same penalty as is provided in the general law
8 of the State for illegal fishing for and catching trout and
9 land-locked salmon.

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
2 police courts and trial justices within their respective coun-
3 ties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent
4 jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and superior courts,
5 and all fines, forfeitures and penalties recovered for viola-
6 tion of this act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiv-
7 ing the same to the State treasurer, and credited to fines and
8 license fees for the protection of birds and game.
