STATE OF MAINE.

IN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,

March 26, 1909.

Ordered, The Senate concurring, that a special joint committee of three on the part of the House, with such as the Senate may join, be appointed to investigate the system of committee hearing advertising, and into the amount of compensation received by all State and county officials whose salaries are determinable by the Legislature. Said committee is hereby authorized to sit during any recess and after the adjournment of the present session, with full power to employ a stenographer, summon, administer oaths to and examine witnesses, call for books and papers, and in general to obtain all necessary information upon which may be based legislative

action looking towards equalization of salaries, and systematization of the committee hearing advertising method, and report in writing, which report shall be filed with the Clerk of the House not later than Dec. 1, 1910, and be referred to the next Legislature without further action thereon.
