AN ACT to amend Chapter Nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to Requirements of the Treasurer's Warrant.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section thirty-seven of chapter nine of the 2 revised statutes is hereby amended, by inserting after the 3 words "real estate" in the fourth line thereof the words 4 'specifying separately the land and the improvements there- 5 on' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 37. The treasurer, in his warrant, shall require 7 said assessors to make a fair list of their assessments, set- 8 ting forth in distinct columns against each person's name,

9 how much he is assessed for a poll, how much for real estate,  
10 specifying separately the land and the improvements thereon,  
11 and how much for personal estate, distinguishing any sum  
12 assessed to such person as guardian, or for any estate in his  
13 possession as executor, administrator or trustee; to insert in  
14 such list the number of acres of land assessed to each non-  
15 resident proprietor, and the value at which they have esti-  
16 mated them; to commit such list, when completed and signed  
17 by a majority of them, to the collector or constable of such  
18 town or other place, with their warrants in due form requir-  
19 ing them to collect and pay the same to the treasurer of such  
20 town or other place, at such time as the legislature, in the  
21 act authorizing such tax, directed them to be paid; and to  
22 return a certificate of the names of such officers and the  
23 amount so committed to each, two months at least before  
24 the time at which they are required to pay in such tax.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
