STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT for the better observance of Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to have in possession any
2 firearms outside of one's dwelling place or camp on Sunday
3 except soldiers in the performance of their military duties
4 and officers of the law in the performance of their official
5 duties, under a penalty of the forfeiture of firearms found
6 in possession in violation of the provisions of this Act, and
7 a further penalty of \$10 and costs for each offense.

Sect. 2. It shall be the duty of sheriffs, deputy sheriffs,
2 police officers, constables and fish and game wardens to
3 faithfully enforce the provisions of this Act.
