STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of Camden & Rockland Water Co.

Resolved, That the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars
2 is hereby appropriated to be paid to the Camden & Rock-
3 land Water Co., in payment of amount due said Company
4 for water furnished the Maine State Prison, from July 1,
5 1908, to January 1, 1909.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Under contract with the State, the Camden & Rockland Water Company have furnished water for the State Prison for a number of years, at \$2,500.00 per year, payable semi-annually. One-half of each year's appropriation has been used for the payment of bill accrued the previous year, with the result that at the beginning of each year, six months water bill on the old year remains unpaid. It will be understood that this resolve does not provide for an advance payment, but simply provides for the payment of water already furnished.
