AN ACT regulating the compensation of the Register of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and seventy-seven of the
2 Public Laws of the State of Maine for the year one thou-
3 sand nine hundred and seven is hereby amended by chang-
4 ing that part relating to the salary of the register of deeds
5 for Penobscot County so that the particular part of said
6 section shall read as follows: 'Penobscot, seventeen hun-
7 dred dollars, with sixteen hundred dollars additional, or so
8 much thereof as may be actually necessary, for clerk hire.'
