IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to require motor boats to be provided with mufflers
in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Motor boats not engaged in interstate com-
2 merce run or operated within one mile of a dwelling house
3 in any tidal or other waters within the State, without the
4 use of mufflers or other suitable devices to deaden sound,
5 are common nuisances within the meaning of and subject
6 to the penalties provided by Revised Statutes, chapter 22,
7 sections 12 and 13.
