STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT relating to the issue of bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

. Section 1. The provisions of chapter seventy-one of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and seven shall not be
3 deemed to prevent any county, city, town or water district,
4 or municipal, private or other corporation organized under
5 the laws of the State from issuing bonds and making them
6 payable in the same manner as it might do if the said chap-
7 ter were not enacted. And no bonds heretofore issued, if
8 valid in other respects, shall be deemed invalid on account
9 of any failure to comply with the provisions of the said
10 chapter.
