STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section thirty of chapter fifteen of the
Revised Statutes, relating to members of Superintending
School Committees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty of chapter fifteen of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence,
3 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 30. School committees first chosen shall designate
5 by lot a member or members to hold office for one, two and
6 three years respectively, in manner as follows: one for one
7 year, one for two years and one for three years; and they
8 shall certify such designation to the town clerk to be by
9 him recorded; and thereafterwards one member shall be

10 chosen by ballot at the annual meeting of the town, to hold
11 office for three years. Said committee may fill vacancies
12 occurring between annual meetings, and the term of office
13 of any member of the committee so chosen shall expire at
14 the next annual meeting.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect July first, one thousand
2 nine hundred and nine.
