STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT relating to air-brakes on Street Railway cars.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That from and after January 1st, 1910, it shall
2 be unlawful for any street railway, engaged in the carrying
3 of passengers or freight, to use or cause to be used any car
4 on any of its lines, unless the same is equipped with an auto-
5 matic air-brake, or some other safety power brake.

Sect. 2. Any railroad company or corporation failing to
2 comply with the provisions of this act shall be punished by
3 a fine of not less than one hundred nor more than five hun-
4 dred dollars for each day that any car is run over any of its
5 lines without such brake, to be recovered on complaint and
6 indictment.
