STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of aid in building a highway from Pleasant Ridge to Dead River in Somerset County.

Resolved: That the sum of twenty thousand dollars be 2 and hereby is appropriated from any unexpended moneys 3 in the Treasury to aid in building a highway from the end 4 of the road in Pleasant Ridge plantation to the Dead River 5 Road in Dead River plantation, all in the County of Som-6 erset.

Provided, That the sum of fifteen thousand dollars be 8 raised by said county or otherwise, which together with the 9 amount herein appropriated, shall be sufficient to complete 10 said road within two years from the date of the approval of 11 this resolve without further aid from the State. And said 12 county is hereby authorized to raise the sum herein pro-13 vided for it to raise, by taxation or otherwise, within the

14 two years above prescribed; and no part of the State aid 15 herein provided shall be paid until said sum of fifteen thou-16 sand dollars shall be raised by said county or otherwise to 17 aid in carrying out the purposes of this resolve.

Provided also, That the location and construction of said 19 road shall be under the supervision of the County Commis-20 sioners of Somerset County and the State Highway Commis-21 sioner. All moneys under this resolve shall be paid upon 22 vouchers satisfactory to the Governor and Council.

Provided further, That said road shall be built on a basis 24 of thirty-five thousand dollars and that the amount paid by 25 the State under this resolve shall not exceed four-sevenths of 26 the cost.
