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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to make permanent the tenure of service of the  
janitors and engineers of the Public Buildings of the City  
of Portland.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The janitors and engineers of the public build-  
ings of the city of Portland shall be continued in the service  
of said city during good behavior, subject however to re-  
moval after a hearing, for inefficiency or other cause by the  
committee on public buildings of the city council of said  
city.

Sect. 2. The provisions of section one of this act shall  
apply to and govern the tenure of service of all janitors and  
engineers hereafter appointed or elected by the city of Port-  
land.
