STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to provide for ice fishing, as provided in the general law of the State, in South Branch, Carpenter, Littlefield and Fowler ponds, Piscataquis County, also to close Davis pond, Penobscot County, to all kinds of fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. So much of section I of chapter 407 of the 2 private and special laws of 1905 as prohibits ice fishing in

- 3 South Branch, Carpenter, Littlefield and Fowler ponds, in
- 4 Piscataquis County, in accordance with the general law of
- 5 the State, is hereby repealed.

- Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or 2 kill any kind of fish at any time for three years from the 3 time this act takes effect, in Davis pond, so-called, in Town-4 ship 5, Range 7, Penobscot County. Whoever violates any 5 of the provisions of this section shall be subject to the same 6 penalty as is provided in the general law of the State for 7 illegal fishing.
- Sect. 3. Municipal and police judges and trial justices in 2 their respective counties shall have original and concurrent 3 jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts in all 4 offenses arising under this act.
