STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to make permanent the tenure of office of the City
Electrician of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The city electrician of the city of Portland
2 shall be continued in the service of said city without reelec-
3 tion, and shall hold office during good behavior, subject,
4 however, after a hearing, to removal at any time by the
5 mayor, with the consent and approval of the aldermen of
6 said city.
