STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in aid of the Piscataquis County Historical Society.

Resolved, Whereas, the Piscataquis County Historical So2 ciety proposes to publish a volume, containing the early his3 tory of Piscataquis County and Eastern Maine, consisting
4 of documentary and other historical matter; and, whereas,
5 the funds of said society derivable from its annual dues are
6 insufficient for this purpose; and, whereas, it is the policy of
7 this State to encourage the compilation and publication of
8 the history of all sections of the State of Maine; and to give
9 financial assistance when the circumstances warrant there10 fore.

Resolved, That the Governor and Council are herby author-2 ized to enter into a contract with the Piscataquis County 3 Historical Society to afford encouragement in aid of such 4 publication, and to subscribe for, not exceeding five hundred 5 volumes the same to be delivered to the State librarian for 6 distribution and exchange purposes; provided the price of 7 the volume printed and distributed for the use of the State 8 shall not exceed two dollars per volume, of not less than 9 three hundred pages each, with suitable indexes and binding, 10 and said volume to be properly edited and compiled by said 11 society without expense to the State.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars be, and 2 hereby is, appropriated for the purpose of carrying out this 3 resolution, and said sum to be expended under the direction 4 of the Governor and Council.
