STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Sections 27 and 28 of Chapter 9 of the Revised Statutes relating to Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 27 of Chapter 9 of the Revised

- 2 Statutes be and hereby is amended by inserting therein after
- 3 the word "vessels," wherever the same appears, the words
- 4 'and barges,' and by adding to said section the words, 'The
- 5 provisions of this section shall not apply to steam barges,'
- 6 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 27. All sailing vessels and barges registered or 8 enrolled under the laws of the United States or foreign governments, owned wholly or in part by inhabitants of this
State, shall be taxed upon an appraised value of twenty
II dollars a ton gross tonnage for new vessels and barges
I2 completed on or before the first day of April of each year.
I3 Vessels or barges one year old or more shall be reduced in
I4 value at the rate of one dollar a ton a year for each additional
I5 year of age, until they shall have reached the age of sevenI6 teen years, at and after which time said vessels and barges
I7 shall be taxed upon an appraised value of three dollars a
I8 ton, gross tonnage. The provisions of this section shall
I9 not apply to steam barges.'

Sect. 2. That Section 28 of Chapter 9 of the Revised 2 Statutes be and hereby is amended by inserting after the 3 word "vessels" in the first line thereof, and after the word 4 "vessels" the first time it appears in the second line thereof, 5 and after the word "vessels" the last time it appears in the 6 fourth line thereof, and after the word "vessels" in the 7 sixth line thereof, the words 'and barges' and by inserting 8 after the word "vessel" in all the other places where it 9 appears in said section the words 'or barge,' and by adding 10 to said section the words 'The provisions of this section 11 shall not apply to steam barges,' so that said section as 12 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 28. Vessels and barges when rebuilt shall be taxed 14 on the same valuation as vessels and barges of one half 15 the age of such rebuilt vessels or barges. A vessel or barge 16 shall be regarded as rebuilt only on an expenditure being

17 made of not less than forty per cent. of the cost of such 18 vessel or barge if built entirely new. Vessels and barges 19 if repaired to the extent of twenty-five per cent. of the cost 20 of such vessel or barge if built entirely new, shall be taxed 21 upon the same valuation as vessels and barges of five-eighths 22 the age of such repaired vessel or barge. The provisions 23 of this section shall not apply to steam barges.'
